Run by Speakers Trust and funded by the Jack Petchey Foundation, the "Speak Out" Challenge! offers every secondary school in London and Essex one complimentary public speaking workshop for 25 Year 10 students. Additional part-funded workshops are available to the full year group should a school wish to extend the opportunity.

The training students receive is designed to build confidence, enabling young people from all backgrounds to speak with clarity, conviction and impact.

We help everyone who takes part in our training to become better communicators, with a greater awareness of the importance of speaking out. This improves education and employment prospects as well as the desire to use the power of their voice to bring positive change.

The "Speak Out" Challenge! includes a competition element where speakers compete in a school assembly for the chance to represent their school in a Regional Final. 15 of these Regional Champions will speak at the Grand Final for the opportunity to win first prize: a £2,000 trust bond for the student and £3,000 for their school.
