Year 10 - Sky Academy Studios - Tuesday 2nd April 2019

The Ongar Academy are delighted to announce that an exciting trip has been organised for 32 students, on a first come first served basis, in Year 10 to visit the Sky Academy Studios, on Tuesday 2nd April 2019. This will be a fun and informative educational experience at Sky's headquarters in Osterley, West London.

The trip to Sky's headquarters will involve students making their very own TV report, short film or pitch video based on subjects they are studying at school. They will get to work with amazing technology, including green screens, broadcast quality cameras and bespoke touch screen edit tables.

During the visit, students will experience:

- A behind the scenes tour of Sky Studios.
- A hands-on learning experience creating their own TV report, short film or pitch video.
- The chance to work with Sky's team of experts with their cutting-edge technology.

At the end of the experience, students will have produced a final video to take home, in the format of a USB wristband or accessed online via a link.

The cost of the trip will be £13.00 per student, covering the cost for transportation.

The coach will arrive at The Ongar Academy at 7:30am and return at approximately 14.30pm, traffic permitting. Students will need to bring appropriate food and drink as there is no food available to purchase onsite. They are required to wear correct school uniform, as we should return just before the end of the school day.

Parents and carers should be aware that we cannot guarantee a place on this visit for any student who do not return their consent form and medical consent form. Submitting the consent form, without paying the £13 via Wisepay before the deadline of Friday 15th March will **not** guarantee your son/daughter's place on the trip. If there is a lower level of response to this visit than anticipated, parents and carers may be asked for an increased contribution, or the visit may be deemed non-viable and cancelled.
