



It's a Bug's Life!

Have you ever wondered what it must be like to be a bug? What sort of different bugs there are? Your task is to find out about one invertebrate in 5 different habitats (rocky shoreline, desert, rainforest, garden, pond and house) and present your research using one of the choices shown below.

You must choose one of the following tasks:

- Make a large poster
- Produce a presentation
- Write a story

Key Ideas:

Here are some things you might like to include.

- What do the invertebrates look like?
- What do they eat?
- How do they reproduce?
- What features does the habitat have?
- Does anything eat them

Stepping Stones

1. Spend about 1 hour researching the key ideas (see above) to find some useful information and pictures to use in your work.
2. Spend about $\frac{1}{2}$ an hour planning how you will turn your ideas into the final piece of work.
3. The rest of the time should be used to create your final piece of work (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 hours)
